SPOTLIGHT ON VOLUNTEERS

Refugee Committee – The Refugee Sponsorship Committee is a small group of committed volunteers working closely with the Roman Catholic Diocese (Sponsorship Agreement Holder). The committee meets on a monthly basis (and as needed) to discuss and support a potential refugee family or individual in the sponsorship process. Each member bring their individual gifts and talents to the table to assist in ways that include the provision of settlement and integration support to newcomers, along with a range of services to support vulnerable refugee arrivals in Canada.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

St. Augustine RCIA volunteers provide instruction and preparation for adults and older children who wish to be baptized in the Catholic Church, and for those converting to Catholicism. They help the pastor evaluate suitability of candidates/catechumens; they organize and facilitate formation programs for the candidates; they also attend RCIA rituals.
